Its Jurassic Park setting makes the 44 luxury villas, on land and on water, therapeutic counterpoints to life in the fast lane—literally, because the water supply for the taking-things-slowly outdoor hot tubs in the garden villas derive from the bubbling hot springs nearby. This resort, also the Best Spa award winner this year (and last), continues to attract travellers seeking wellness getaways. Guests also come to sample Ipoh's finest bistro cuisine at Jeff's Cellar, a standout restaurant embedded within the caverns of a limestone hill.
